



SCHEDULE OF CHARGES

Purpose

This Fact Sheet provides a summary of charges applied by AMSA for the issuing of maritime qualifications to crew members on Australian ships.

What are AMSA charges?

AMSA provides a range of services which broadly fall into two categories: marine services and shipping registration. Marine services relate to approvals, certificates, licences, inspections, determinations and exemptions required by the legislation and related regulations or Marine Orders administered by AMSA. Shipping registration relates to services by the Shipping Registration Office.

Charges are applied for all of these services, and these are set at a level aimed at recovering the cost of providing each of the services in question. AMSA's costs in providing marine services and ship registration are primarily labour related, with low capital costs, with charges set either at a fixed rate or at an hourly rate. The hourly rate for providing marine services is \$272.

AMSA's charges are supported by its [Cost Recovery Impact Statement \(CRIS\)](#), certified in September 2015.

The charges are authorised by [AMSA's Determination Fixing Charges of 2015](#), issued under Section 47(1) of the *Australian Maritime Safety Authority Act 1990*.

Unless otherwise stated, the charges for the above services are exempt from the Goods and Services Tax (GST).

What will I be charged?

The charges applicable for each of the following services are:

Processing of application for the issue of an Australian Seafarer's Service Book	\$112
Additional charge for transmission of documents other than by regular mail, such as fax, email or courier	within Australia \$40 outside Australia \$80

Where and how do I pay these charges in Australia?

- For fees associated with Form [AMSA419](#), these must be paid at Australia Post at the time of lodging the application. Australia Post will issue a receipt for every charge paid and record the receipt number on the application form. - For fees associated with Oral Examinations, these must be paid at the Examination Centre when it confirms the time and date of your appointment;
- Payment in the form of Eftpos, credit card or cash will be accepted. Cheques will not be accepted.
