Shipping Registration Act 1981

NOTES

1. Proposed Name of Ship

Names that may not be approved are:

- names that are the same as or similar to names of registered ships or of ships about to be registered,
- blasphemous or otherwise offensive names,
- names of members of the Royal family,
- names that falsely suggest a connection with the Royal family, or international, national, state or local government bodies,
- names that include prefixes capable of indicating a type of ship (e.g. MV, FV, SS).

WA: Broome, Fremantle, Dampier, Port Hedland.

TAS: Hobart, Burnie, Devonport, Launceston.

NT: Darwin, Gove Harbour
