WHEN TO USE THIS FORM

Register for an Australian Maritime Mobile Service Identity (MMSI) number, if you own the following types of equipment aboard a recreational or commercial maritime vessel, coast station or SAR Aircraft:

- a Fixed MF/ HF DSC radio
- a Fixed VHF DSC radio
- · a handheld VHF DSC radio; or
- AIS Class A or Class B transceiver

Registration is FREE.

MMSI for AIS shore stations

If you require an MMSI for an AIS base station, repeater, AIS Aids to Navigation, etc, **PLEASE USE AMSA FORM 234.**

PROFICIENCY CERTIFICATES REQUIRED

To be eligible for issue of an MMSI number you must have obtained one of the proficiency certificates listed below:

- Australian Waters Qualification (AWQ)
- GMDSS First-Class Radio Electronic Certificate (1st Class REC)
- GMDSS Second-Class Radio Electronic Certificate (2nd Class REC)
- GMDSS General Operator's Certificate of Proficiency (GOCP)
- · Restricted Radio Operator's Certificate of Proficiency (RROCP)
- Long Range Certificate (Marine Radio Operators Certificate of Proficiency MROCP)
- Short Range Certificate of Proficiency (Marine Radio Operator's VHF Certificate of Proficiency MROVCP)

Note 1: If a MF/HF Fixed radio is aboard you must register the radio with the Australian Communications and Media Authority (ACMA), and have an Australian radio callsign before applying for a MMSI number.

Note 2: Marine radio operator qualifications are not required for AIS on SAR aircraft, AIS base stations or AIS Aids to Navigation.

Note 3: AWQ is accepted for VHF and AIS operating in Australian waters only.

Note 4: Diver Handheld VHF DSC transceivers – marine radio operator qualifications are not required if the radio operator in the diving boat (mother vessel) is qualified. In the case of lone divers not operating from boats, the requirement for a marine radio operator certificate remains.

If the radio equipment is for a **maritime vessel** – Complete sections A, B and E If the radio equipment is for a **coast station** – Complete section A, C and E If the radio equipment is for a **SAR aircraft** – Complete sections A, D and E
